

REBOOK YOUR TEST

CANDIDATE - WHY DO I HAVE TO WAIT FOR 10 DAYS BEFORE BOOKING ANOTHER DRIVING TEST?

MOHAMMED YAMINE - IF YOU DIDN'T PASS THE LAST DRIVING TEST, YOU CAN REBOOK YOUR NEXT TEST ONLY AFTER 10 DAYS ACCORDING TO THE DVSA RULE.

BOOK YOUR DRIVING TEST ONCE AGAIN & GET READY TO BE SUCCESSFUL THIS TIME.

FOR EXAMPLE, IF YOUR LAST DATE FOR THE DRIVING TEST WAS THE IST OF JULY, MONDAY,

THEN YOUR NEXT DRIVING TEST DATE WILL BE THE 13TH OF JULY AT THE EARLIEST.

START COUNTING (NOT SUNDAY) THE 1ST DAY, RIGHT AFTER THE NEXT DAY OF FAILING THE DRIVING TEST.

THE DVSA LAYS DOWN A 10 WORKING DAY RULE









'THE DVSA LAYS DOWN A 10 WORKING DAY RULE'

It states that a candidate cannot take another driving test for 10 working days when the DVSA works.

Working days for DVSA are Monday to Saturday

Learners might consider Sundays as a working day & miscalculate the earliest driving test date that they can take.

Persevere and concentrate - And you will succeed next time!
