

DUAL CARRIAGEWAYS

A ROAD THAT HAS A CENTRAL RESERVATION TO SEPARATE THE CARRIAGEWAYS IS A DUAL CARRIAGEWAY. IT IS IMPORTANT TO STAY IN THE LEFT-HAND LANE WHILE DRIVING ON A DUAL-CARRIAGEWAY.

THE RIGHT-HAND LANE SHOULD ONLY BE USED FOR OVERTAKING OR TURNING RIGHT. AFTER OVERTAKING AND WHEN IT'S SAFE, YOU SHOULD MOVE BACK TO THE LEFT-HAND LANE AGAIN

ON A THREE-LANE DUAL CARRIAGEWAY, YOU CAN USE THE MIDDLE OR RIGHT-HAND LANE TO OVERTAKE, BUT REMEMBER TO RETURN TO THE MIDDLE LANE AND THEN MOVE TO THE LEFT-HAND LANE WHEN IT'S SAFE.
