# Driving Lessons for Beginners

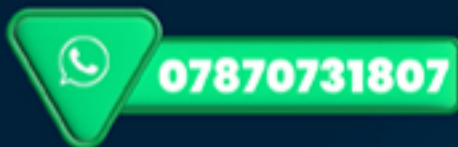
- Step 1 P-Prepare

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# WHAT GEARS SHOULD YOU USE WHILE DRIVING?

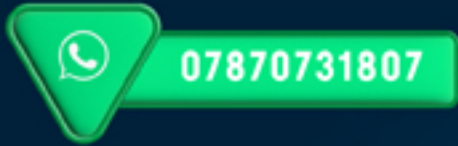


1ST GEAR - 0 TO 10MPH  
2ND GEAR - 10 TO 20MPH  
3RD GEAR - 20 TO 30MPH  
4TH GEAR - 30 TO 40MPH  
5TH GEAR - 40 TO 60MPH  
6TH GEAR - 60+ MPH

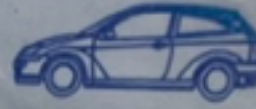
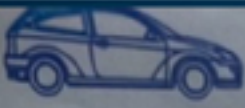


**NOW SHIFT YOUR GEARS SMOOTHLY WITH PRECISE CONTROL.**





## CHANGING GEARS



**DO's**

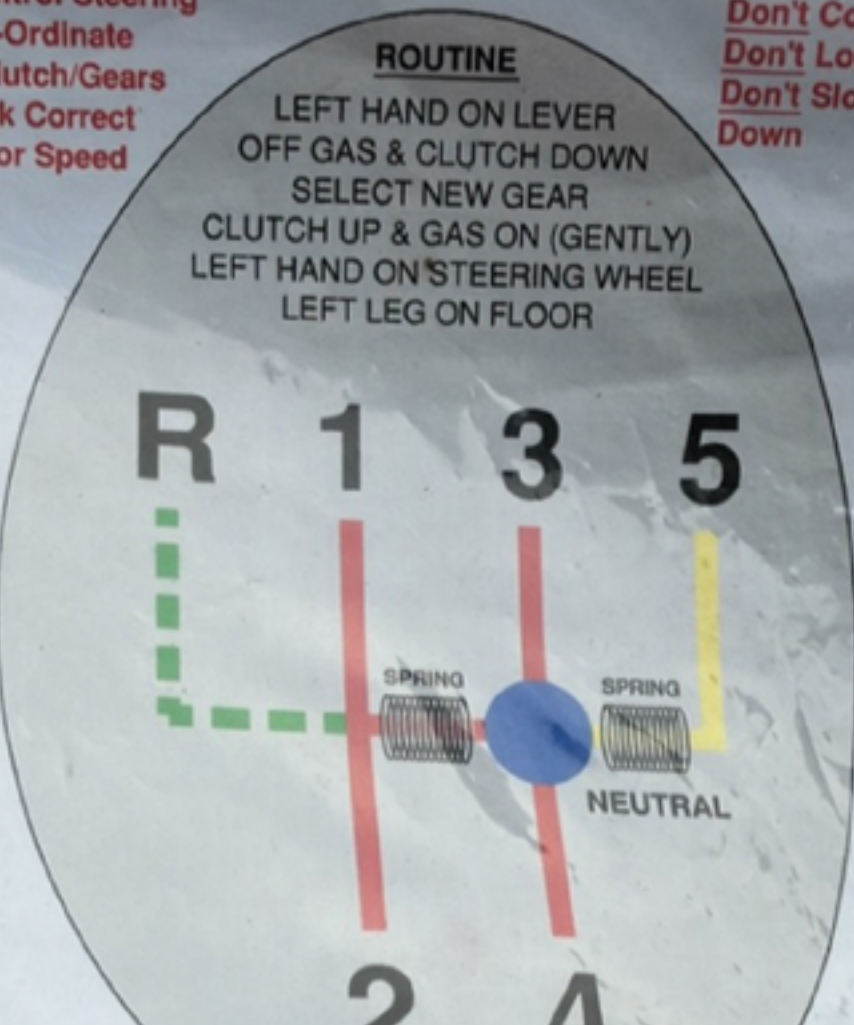
- Do** Control Steering
- Do** Co-Ordinate Gas/Clutch/Gears
- Do** pick Correct Gear for Speed

**ROUTINE**

LEFT HAND ON LEVER  
OFF GAS & CLUTCH DOWN  
SELECT NEW GEAR  
CLUTCH UP & GAS ON (GENTLY)  
LEFT HAND ON STEERING WHEEL  
LEFT LEG ON FLOOR

**Don'ts**

- Don't** Coast
- Don't** Look Down
- Don't** Slow Car Down

- C.C.** = 00 to 3mph
- 1st** = 04 - 10 mph
- 2nd** = 06 - 20 mph
- 3rd** = 15 - 40 mph
- 4th** = 25 - 50 mph
- 5th** = 45mph +
